Market Overview

Retail is one of the largest industry sectors in the United States in terms of the number of establishments and number of employees. According to the US Census Bureau, the total amount of sales for the retail industry (including food services and automotive) was \$5.4 trillion in 2019.1

The amount of information used to plan and operate a retail business makes Enterprise Content Management invaluable for today's retailer. With increasing competition and escalating operational expenses, gross margins are dependant upon cost effective management of data and other information. Whether at the franchise or corporate headquarters, retailers must keep tight control over customer and supplier transactions, contracts, employee records, accounting documents and inventory reports. This need, coupled with the



growing use of the internet, offers a business case for the latest in information technology. Retailers no longer ask themselves whether information technology is needed to maintain a competitive advantage. Growth Opportunity



Information technology spending by retailers is expected to grow by an average of 10.6% per year and to reach an estimated \$270.5 billion by 2024.2 A key reason for the rise in IT spending is "the pressure to continue to realize cost savings from supply chain

efficiencies while improving customer service," according to Tony Friscia, president and CEO of AMR Research. The growing integration of artificial intelligence and machine learning in platforms is a major driver of market growth.³

Global spending on cybersecurity is expected to exceed a cumulative \$1.75 trillion from 2021-2025., according to Cybersecurity Ventures. "In 2004, the global cybersecurity market was worth just \$35 billion and now it's one of the largest and fastest-growing sectors in the information economy," Cybersecurity Ventures founder Steve Morgan says.9





Drivers of growth

Retailers see investments in information management as a means to gain a competitive edge. Walmart and other big-box retailers have used it to change the retail playing field and drive less-effective retailers out of business. As a result, technological innovations are typically seen as the first step toward efficiency and a competitive leg up. For years, IT spending has remained strong. In addition to leveraging IT investments to create process efficiencies, retailers are increasing IT budgets to comply with regulations that require them to protect customer information.

Trend One: Protecting Customer Information



Protecting customer information has never been more important or so difficult for retailers. Data security breaches are common and they continue to tarnish the reputation of the retail industry. According to Statista, more than 750 million customer records in the US were compromised between 2018 and 2020.4 The list of retailers hit by data breaches in 2021 include Hobby Lobby, Volkswagen, supermarket chain Wegmans and

apparel sellers Carter's, Bonobos and Guess, according to researcher Security Intelligence.⁵ The costs to a company can run into the millions of dollars after factoring the money spent on fines and penalties, credit monitoring services, lawsuits and information technology fixes, the researcher says. It isn't only

large retailers at risk. More than 40% of breach victims are small businesses, according to a Verizon study. To battle computer hackers and data thieves, the major credit card providers have implemented network security and data handling rules for retailers and credit card payment processors.

Trend Two: Connecting Stores Through the Cloud



Retailers are looking to save money and time on collecting, managing and storing customer and business records from multiple store locations. They want the ability for important business information to be instantly and securely collected,

accessed, searched and shared across the entire company, linking together central and regional offices, stores, administrative departments and warehouses.

Competition is stiff and consumers have ever-increasing demands. To meet those demands and stay on top, retailers need to operate as efficiently as possible and control costs. Franchises and retailers with multiple locations face the challenge of organizing and sharing information across disparate systems. Managing information for thousands of customers, distributors and dealers can be labor intensive and costly. Ensuring every store

has access to up-to-date pricing sheets and discounting schedules is important to business consistency and success.

Paper-based record-keeping processes stifle productivity and profitability. Another retailer challenge is high employee turnover. Training across multiple information systems can become time consuming and confusing for new employees, as well as expensive for employers. For most retailers, information management systems are a root source of

Trend Six: Complying with Payment Card Data Security Standards

The Payment Card Industry (PCI) Security Standards Council is an open global forum for the ongoing

development of security standards for account data protection. The council owns, develops, maintains and distributes the PCI Data Security Standard (PCI DSS).

PCI DSS Requirements

PCI DSS is comprised of a list of general requirements designed to:

- Build and maintain a secure network
- Protect cardholder data
- Maintain a vulnerability management program
- Implement strong access control measures
- Regularly monitor and test networks
- Maintain an information security policy



Because banks, insurers, and credit card providers must reimburse consumers whose credit card data is stolen, they are pressuring retailers to comply with PCI DSS or share the liability for any losses.

William Beer, director of information security practice at PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC), said, "Consumer trust is being tested as more and more personal information is being placed in the hands of companies, but even the most respected organizations that are expected to have water-tight security are being breached as hackers become more sophisticated." Threats of future hacks and huge monetary losses highlight the need for the best information security.



Budgeting for Compliance

A recent compliance study revealed that each year companies spend between \$3 and \$33 per worker to comply with data protection regulations.⁶

Vocabulary and Terminology

The following are basic terms and concepts for speaking to a prospect from a retail business.

Data Security Standard (DSS)

Data Security Standard represents a common set of industry tools and measurements to help ensure the safe handling of sensitive information. The standard provides an actionable framework for developing an account data security process, including preventing, detecting and reacting to security incidents.

PCI Security Standards Council (PCI)

The PCI Security Standards Council is an open global forum for the ongoing development, enhancement, storage, dissemination and implementation of security standards for account data protection. American Express, Discover Financial Services, JCB, MasterCard Worldwide and Visa International founded the organization. The PCI Security Standards Council owns, develops, maintains and distributes the PCI Data Security Standard (DSS) and is led by a policy-setting Executive Committee, composed of representatives from the founding payment brands.

Secure Socket Layer (SSL)

SSL is a protocol that provides secure communications over the internet using asymmetric key encryption.

Statement on Auditing Standards

The Statement on Auditing Standards defines standards to assess the general computer controls of a service organization. Developed by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants, the standards are frequently used to evaluate outsourced services like cloud ECM. Service organizations must undergo an extensive examination of internal controls, processes and procedures. The most comprehensive report includes descriptions of both the security controls and the testing, which occurs over a specific period of time.
